



HIPPY (Cabramatta) Home Tutor

Casual position up to 15 hours per week during school terms

Are you looking to start a career working with children and families?

Learning Links is a community-based organisation assisting children with learning difficulties and their families. Learning Links is running the 'Home Interaction Program for Parents and Youngsters' (HIPPY) program in the Cabramatta area. HIPPY is a two year early childhood enrichment program for children and their parents/carers. We urgently require three tutors to work with families who are participating in HIPPY. Positions are available for a two year period and home tutors may have the opportunity to participate in a traineeship.

Essential:

- Home tutors must be enrolled in the HIPPY program with their child (or a child they have regular contact with) over the two years of the program. The child must be in their preschool year and be 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 4 years old.
- Interest and enthusiasm in supporting other families.
- Ability to relate to people from a range of cultural and language backgrounds from within the local area.
- Basic literacy in English including reading and writing.
- Good organisational skills.

Desirable:

- NSW Drivers license and their own car with current NSW registration and comprehensive insurance.
- Access to a mobile phone.
- Second language shared by families in the HIPPY program.
