



EARLY CHILDHOOD SCHOOL READINESS PROGRAM: TERM 3

Support for children who may require some additional preparation for the routines and early learning skills required for kindergarten.

The School Readiness Program is for children starting school in 2020 and is run by a therapist and provisional psychologist to provide additional expertise in the areas of speech, language and motor skills as well as social skills and behaviour.



PREPARING FOR SCHOOL

The program has been developed in reference to Early Years Learning Framework and prepares children in the the following areas:

Language:

- Following directions
- Asking and answering 'Wh-' questions
- Telling a story/news
- Learning new vocabulary

Behaviour and social skills:

- Making friends
- Compromising
- Solving problems
- Initiating conversation
- Turn-taking
- Self-regulation and attention

Pre-literacy and pre-numeracy skills:

- Rhyming
- Word and sound awareness
- Recognising colours and shapes
- Counting

Motor skills:

- Fine motor (pincer grip, cutting, pasting, holding a pencil, drawing, writing name)
- Gross motor (hopping, jumping, skipping)
